The program will open with a showing of a short **documentary** about David's story. We believe that **collaboration** between schools, parents, and students is the best way to address this issue. This is why **we encourage that schools find time for our foundation to present to all groups, whether at the same time or in different sessions.** Involving parents is the key in addressing this issue, and making a positive impact in the lives of students.

#DAVIDSLAW ANTIBULLYING PLEDGE
